



ROCHESTER WESTERN NEW YORK CHAPTER 58 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Program Criteria and Requirements

The purpose of the IREM Chapter 58 Educational Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to an individual interested in furthering their education and career in the field of real estate. The recipients will be awarded course tuition towards any IREM Chapter 58 sponsored educational courses.

Selection Criteria

Applicant must:

- Have a minimum high school diploma or equivalent.
- Demonstrate commitment to real estate management as evidenced by employment in the industry.
- Attend at least three (3) chapter events within the past twelve months.
- Be current on membership dues.
- Level of current or past involvement with the chapter may be considered.

Required Documentation

- Applicant must submit a completed Scholarship Application.
- Signed affidavit signed by employer, if applicable
- Personal statement of need. The written statement should address the financial need, interest and commitment to real estate management as a career.
- Applicant must submit a copy of your current resume.

All applications must be submitted by the last day of the month, at least two (2) months prior to any sponsored course. **DEADLINE for all applications is no later than August 15th for any calendar year.** Scholarship Applications should be sent to IREM Chapter 58, PO Box 202, North Chili, New York 14514 or faxed to 585-889-7688. Scholarship awards must be used for IREM Chapter 58 sponsored courses. Scholarship must be used in the calendar year awarded.

Program Selection Committee

The Scholarship selection committee must consist of the Chapter President, Vice President of Education and Foundation/Scholarship Chairperson and two alternates. Committee must not have any affiliation or connection to applicants. In the event of a conflict of interest, the alternate will fill in for the committee member with the conflict for that selection only.
